



Do you want to volunteer and be a part of an exciting tournament hosted by Innisbrook?

Innisbrook Resort is preparing for The U.S. Pro Women's Clay Court Championships April 13-19, 2020, that draws 64 professional players from around the world to Palm Harbor's only professional tennis tournament. Great players like Sophia Kenin, Coco Gauff, Naomi Osaka, Maria Sharapova, and many more all began their careers playing tournaments like this. Be a part of witnessing the next great one.

We are looking for assistance in the following areas:

- Volunteers during the week of April 13-19, 2020 (ushers, ball runners, ticket registration, parking, court maintenance, etc.)
- Lodging for the players and officials. Lodging only requires a place to stay, however, any transportation &/or a few meals is appreciated.

 Our volunteers will be offered a pass for the day you are working, as well as a day pass to another weekday (Tuesday-Friday) of matches, depending on the hours worked.

Some background information on the U.S. Pro Women's Clay Court Championships:

It's been 34 years since the U.S. Pro Women's Clay Court Championships have played, but Innisbrook Resort has announced the tournament will be revitalized on its courts in April 2020. The U.S. Pro Women's Clay Court Championships began as a national tennis championship for women sanctioned by the United States Tennis Association. The tournament was first hosted in Pittsburgh, Pa. in 1912, two years after the debut of the U.S. Pro Men's Clay Court Championships, with a doubles event added in 1914. The tournament had countless women's champions, including Staffi Graff and Chris Evert, who captured more singles titles at this tournament than any other woman. 74 vears after its beginning, the championship ended its run in Indianapolis, Ind. due to a lack of sponsorship, while the men's competition persevered.

Since we have been busy preparing for the 2020 U.S. Pro Women's Clay Court Championship, we will not be hosting the Men's Pro Invesco Series Event this year.

The timing of this tournament will be ideal. The players will be traveling from Miami to Charleston and then to Innisbrook. They will be able to use this match for more practice prior to heading to the red clay at the French Open. We expect to host some of the top 50 women players in the world. All very exciting!

Blueberry Panna Cotta with Caramelized Hazelnut

For 4 People



- 9OZ FRESH BLUEBERRIES
- 4OZ BLACK CURRANT JUICE
- 4 LEAVES GELATIN
- 10OZ HEAVY CREAM
- 4OZ SUGAR
- 5 TBSP. SKINLESS HAZELNUTS
- NON-STICK SPRAY FOR ALUMINUM FOIL
- ALUMINUM FOIL

Wash blueberries, combine with fruit juice in a tall vessel, puree very fine and pass through a sieve. Soak gelatin in cold water. Boil heavy cream with half of the sugar in a pot and simmer 2-3 minutes. Pour cream through a fine sieve into a bowl, cool down for a short while. Take gelatin out of water and discard all water, dissolve in your cream mixture, add about 5oz of your blueberry puree and mix softly under your cream. Pour into Rocks Glasses or something similar and cool at least 4 hours. Chill remaining blueberry puree.

Combine rest of sugar and 2-3 tbsp. water in a nonstick pan and caramelize golden brown.

In the meantime spray your aluminum foil with non-stick spray and put to side.

Mix hazelnuts in caramel, set caramelized hazelnuts in small portions on the foil and let cool. Take your panna cotta and add your blueberry puree and top with your caramelized hazelnuts as picture shows.
